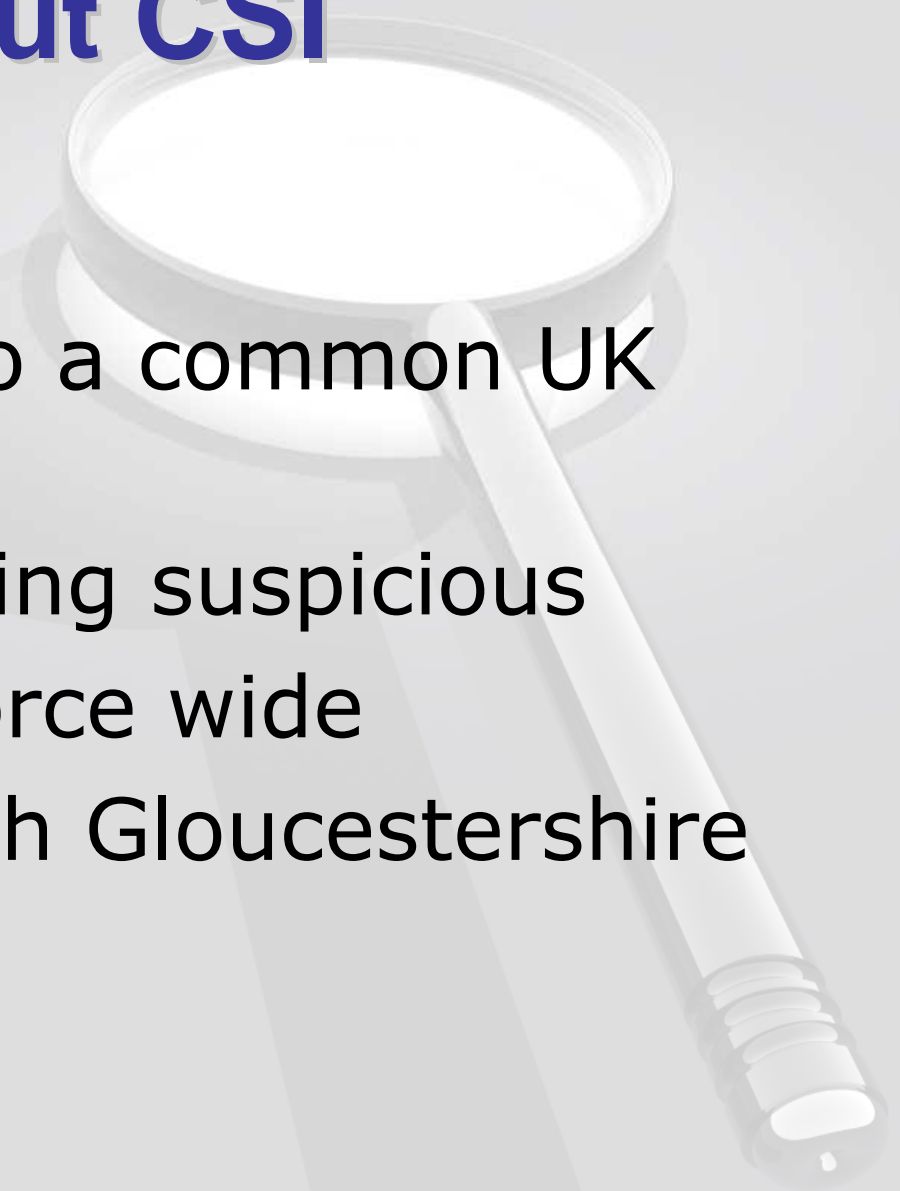

- Cannot be dated:

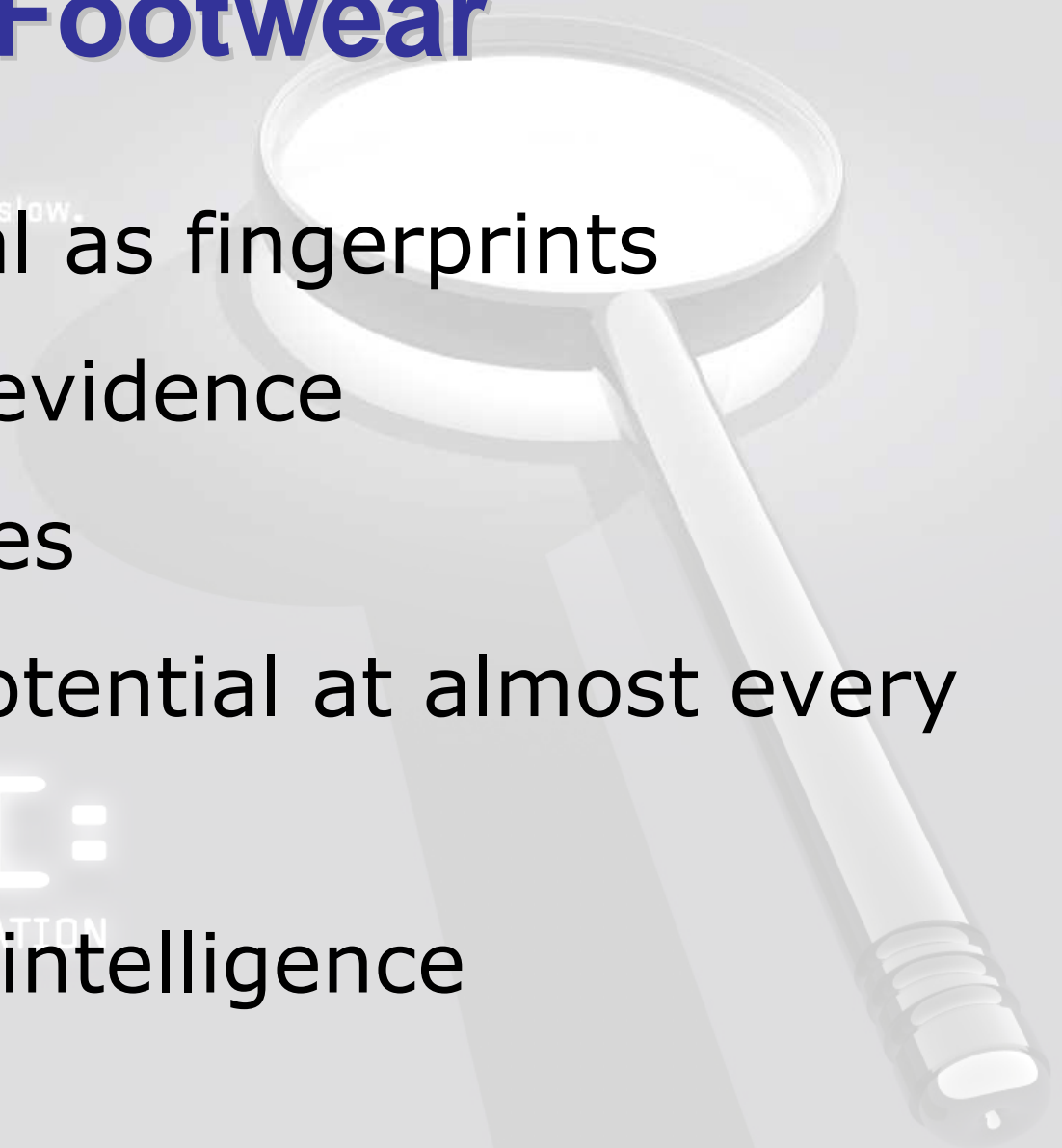

- Recovery potential at almost every scene

Tools

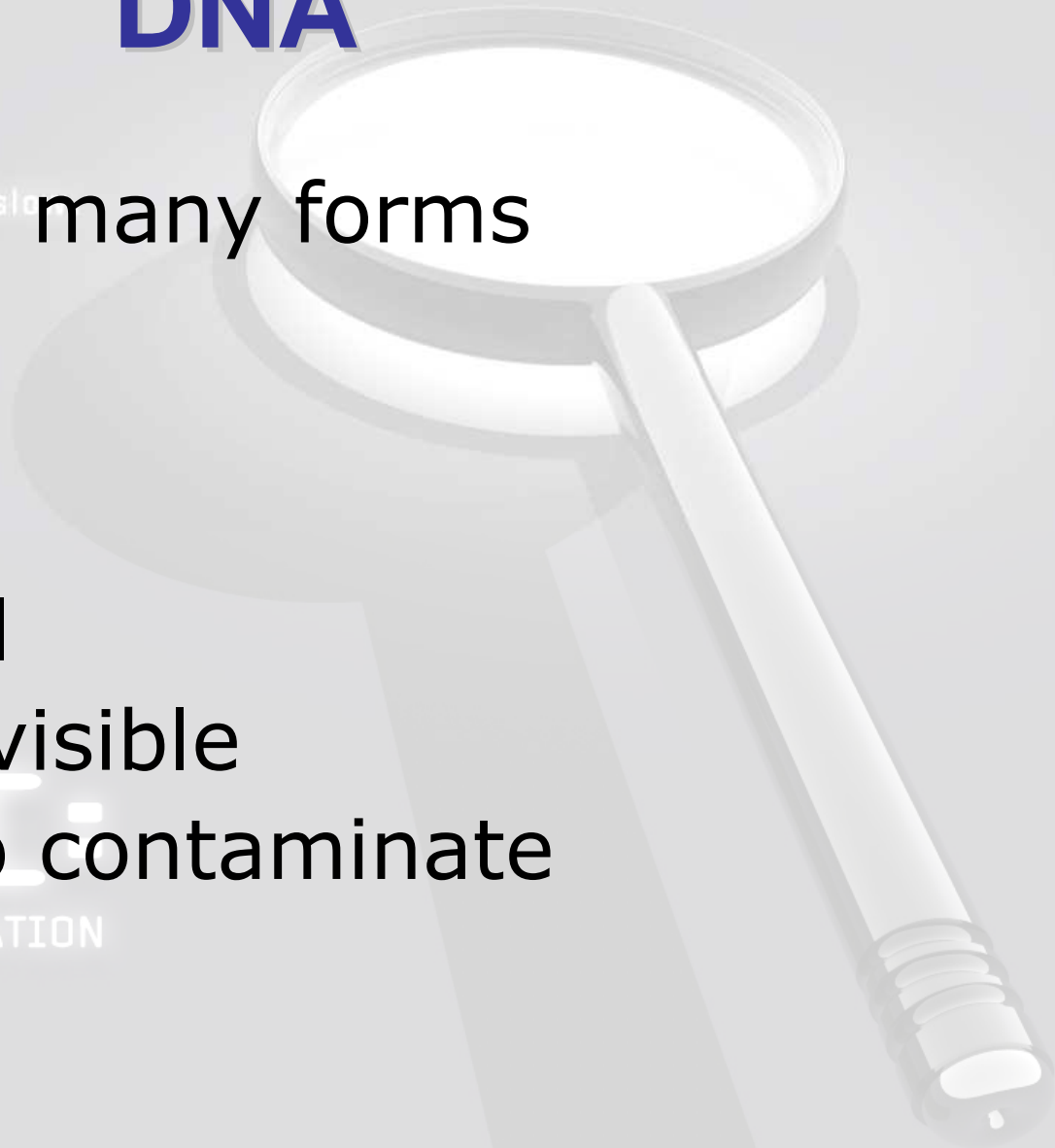
- Most crime scenes involve a tool...
- Screwdrivers, crowbars, garden implements
- Tool marks can be cast and compared
- Conclusive evidence
- Also useful for DNA

DNA

- Can come in many forms
 - Saliva
 - Blood
 - Hair
 - Sperm
 - Sweat
- Unique to all
- Usually not visible
- Very easy to contaminate

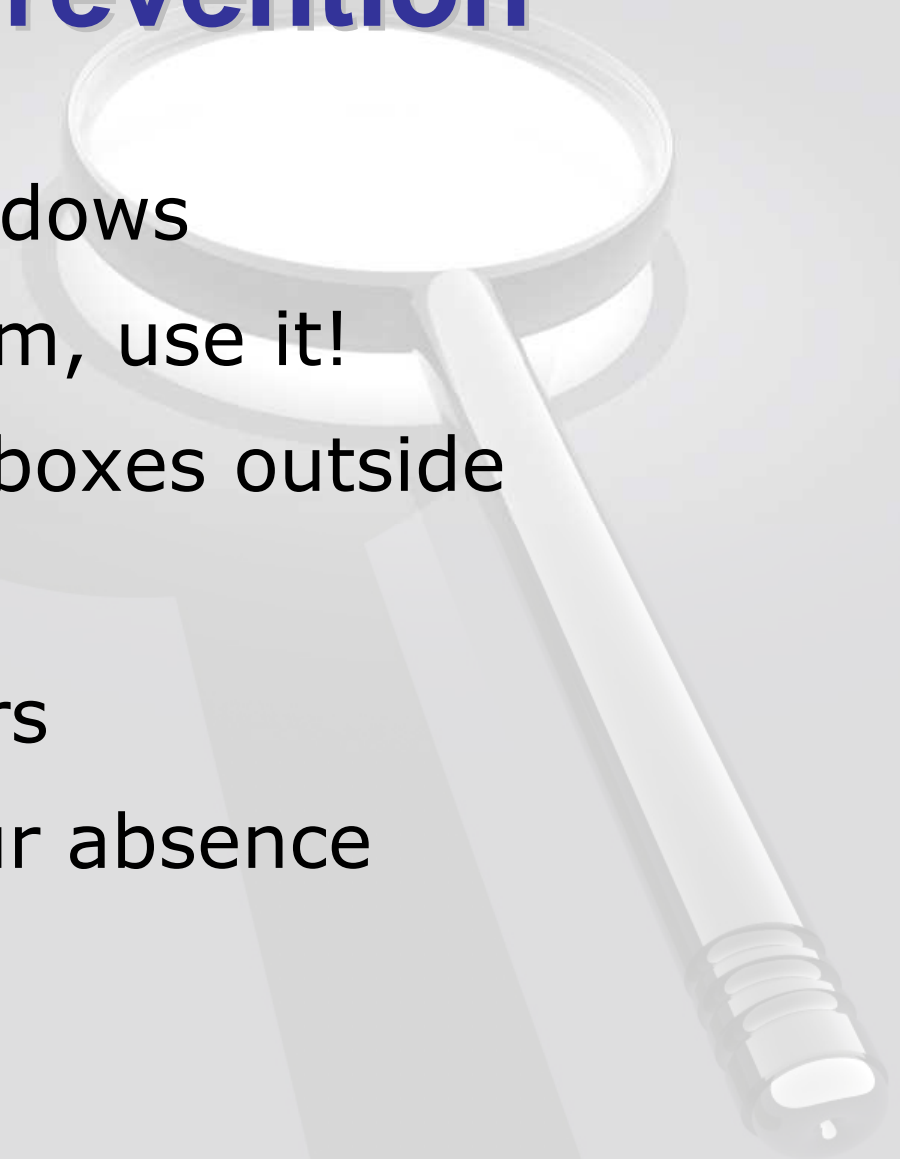
CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

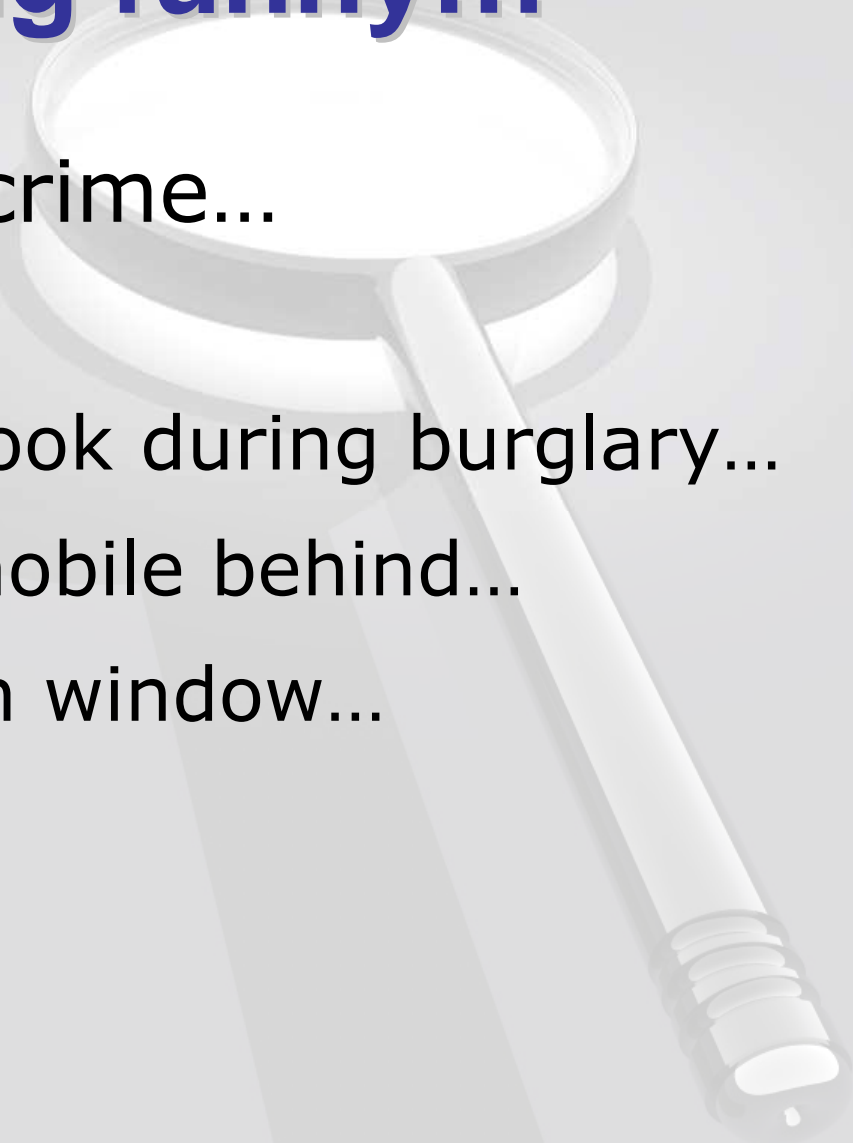


Something funny...
